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Agenda items

- Updates
 - Thanksgiving help (13 families)
 - Tree of Hope (18 families)
 - 59 children
 - Curriculum focused event at Holiday Program
 - 385 adults and 285 students totaling 670 participants
 - FE team discussed principal idea of relocating event to nearby high school to support the participation from parents and have the appropriate facilities
 - FE team discussed providing a survey to parents at meet and greet for SY24-25 to get feedback from parents and to see whether they would participate if event was moved to another location
 - Kinder kickoff
 - 12 families
 - FE survey report results
 - Reviewed result size was (25 participants)
 - Focusing on question 10: “The school offers workshops and informational sessions that help me understand how children learn, ad what they are expected to learn” as 24% survey participants disagreed
 - Will implement information session /handout at upcoming curriculum focused event (3/7/24)
 - Focused on question 20 “What barriers, if any prevent you from being as involved in your child’s education as you would like to be?”

- 4% identified language, 68% identified other/multiple reasons, 24% identified time, 4% identified transportation
 - FE Team discussed other could be identified as work or childcare.

 - Clothing drive by STUDCO ends 2/16/24
 - Canned foods available in case of emergency
 - Storage bins to be ordered to help organize clothing items
